- Your paper will remain in the Congress Program if you (or your co-author) register by **13 May 2020**. If you fail to complete the registration by this date, your paper will be withdrawn from the Congress Program.
- If your paper is co-authored, at least one of the paper authors must complete a registration and present the paper at the Congress.
- You will be asked to submit the complete paper by 1 July 2020.
- All presentations must be made orally in English, French or Portuguese (LOC sessions only) at the Congress, normally no more than 15 minutes.
- Remote presentations (via Skype) are not acceptable.

Congress participants are responsible for covering all Congress and travel expenses such as plane tickets, accommodation, transfer from and to the airport, food, conference fees, etc.

The certificate of attendance and the letter of participation will be available in electronic format (PDF) to registered participants who attended the Congress, as of 30 July 2020 in the [My Congress] user menu.
